and 7, 560 students are there. The institute will be in a position to

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B.O.G. 13.14.7(11) Medical Treatment/Recognition of Hospitals

The Institute is under the process of establishing Health Centre. Only one Medical Officer post was sanctioned and the Institute filled the post. Health Centre is under construction. It is difficult for the health centre to attend the huge population of students, employees and their dependents by one doctor. Accordingly it is proposed that the Board may recognize certain hospitals within and around Chandigarh/Mohali, so that the students, employees and their dependents will be given health care. The Institute has already entered into an MoU with Silver Oak Hospital which was in the list of CGHS recognized hospitals. Institute approached the M/s Fortis Hospital and Fortis has given its consent to certain specialties on CGHS rates (Delhi) and for other multispecialties and OPD and other diagnostic services offered 10-20% discount. Fortis is also in the list of hospitals recognized under the CGHS for some ailments. Another hospital located at Mohali is IVY Hospital, which is also serving many other government agencies like Banks, Semi Conductor Complex, BSNL etc. Further it is also mentioned that IIT Ropar has recognized M/s Fortis Mohali, IVY Hospital Mohali and Chaitanya Hospital Chandigarh. A new hospital that has come up recently in Mohali is Max Health Care (Hospital). Accordingly it is proposed the following hospitals, be recognized for the treatment of students, employees and their dependents. Further the rates/charges/reimbursement shall be in accordance with the rates approved under the CGHS or under the Central Civil Medical Attendance Rules. For the treatment/procedures for which rates are not available, employees may avail the discounts offered by the respective Hospitals and the balance amount of expenditure if any, is to be met by the students & employees. If approved, IISER Mohali may enter into an agreement with these Hospitals.
