	This is for the information of the Board that the Institute had started functioning from July 2007 to fulfill the commitment of Government of India to run the academic programme starting from 2007-08. Accordingly, the Institute needed some faculty for the same. Since at the initial stage there was no Faculty Selection Committee for the purpose and the main aim of the Institution was to implement the Government decision, the Institute appointed some faculty on urgent basis, who were working in different institutions/universities in the country. Dr. Arvind, having a brilliant academic record and had a wide experience of teaching and research activities in university/institution like IIT Madras, was offered the position of a visiting faculty at IISER Mohali on a consolidated salary of Rs.30,000-/ He joined the Institute on August 1, 2007. After the constitution of the

	Selection committee in due course by the Institute, Dr. Arvind was appointed as Associate Professor vide letter No.IISER/07- 08/Faculty/531dated 24/02/2008 and he joined the post on 24/02/08. The case of counting of past services as visiting faculty, on regular basis, w.e.f. the date of joining was placed before the Board in its 3 rd meeting held on April 19, 2008 and the Board after due consideration had approved the proposal and accordingly the services of Dr. Arvind was counted on regular basis w.e.f. the date of joining in this Institute as visiting faculty (i.e. 01/08/07 to 23/02/08). While considering the case of arrear payment in revised scale (i.e. the benefit of 6 th Pay Commission) Dr. Arvind was paid the arrear w.e.f. the date of his services on regular basis w.e.f 24/02/08, though he joined the Institute on 01/08/07 on contractual basis.
