	the students:faculty:non-faculty is 10:1:1.1. The Institute has been
	sanctioned only 96 positions of non-faculty whereas as per the ratio the
	number of non-faculty positions should be 188. The institute is short of 92
	positions. The Shortage of non-faculty is severely affecting the working of
	the Institute.
	MoE is requested to immediately arrange for sanction 92 positions of non-
	faculty. The BOG in its 41 st Meeting held on 30.03.2021 had approved 28
	positions out of 85 positions to be filled on contract till these are sanctioned
	by the Ministry. The Institute advertised these contractual positions and was
	able to fill 11 positions while recruitments for the remainder are being

(additional) posts require approvals from the Administrative Ministry
and M/o Finance. Proposal may be sent to MoE with full details after
approval of BoG.
Comments of MoE: The proposal may be sent to the Ministry for
approval of MoE and Finance Ministry.
The Registrar IISER Mohali informed the BoG that this Agenda Item
has two parts, one was about the request for sanction of 92 additional
regular positions to the institute which is corresponding to sanctioned
faculty strength of 171. This additional number is arrived at since as per
DPR, the ratio between the students:faculty:non-faculty is 10:1:1.1 and
accordingly number of non-faculty positions required are 188, whereas
the sanctioned strength of non-faculty positions in the Institute at
present is 96 and so it requires additional 92 non-faculty positions. The
second part of this Agenda Item was to approve four (04) contractual
positions till these 92 positions are sanctioned by the Ministry. As and
when these 92 positions are sanctioned by the Ministry, these four (04)
posts will be surrendered, so that the total number of regular plus
contractual non-faculty posts will never exceed 188.

	The Institute follows the flexi-cadre scheme for its faculty and has so far not
	formulated a promotion policy for them. Until 2020, individual faculty
	submitted their applications against advertised direct recruitment posts, and
	from amongst the applicants those who were suitably recommended by a
	duly constituted Selection Committee were appointed to the higher faculty
	categories. In 2021 and 2022, the Institute had not advertised for any faculty
	posts except in the form of Special drives for recruitments in the under-
	represented categories (since vacancies were available only in these
	categories), and hence there was no opportunity for faculty to apply through
	the direct recruitment process.
	The matter of formulating a suitable faculty promotion scheme has been
	under discussion at successive BoG meetings since June 2021, that is, for
	nearly two years. One scheme for faculty career advancement was initially
	approved by the Board at its 45 th meeting held on 7.9.2021, and it was then
	modified and rendered more rigorous vide a BoG resolution adopted at the
	47 th meeting on 29.3.2022.

	Under this approved modified scheme, Assessment Committee meetings
	were held on 29 July 2022 to interact with the applicants for faculty career
	advancement and to make recommendations thereon. The Assessment
	Committees were comprised of distinguished scientists/academics who
	either had been nominated by the Board or were chosen from amongst the
	panel approved by the Board, and the meetings were all chaired by the BoG
	Chairperson, Prof. Ajay Sood.
	At the 50 th meeting of BoG held on 10.11.2022, however, the BoG withdrew
	the approval accorded by it earlier on 29.3.2022 for the career advancement
	scheme. This withdrawal was based on the fact that IITs, IISERs follow
	flexi-cadre and that such a career advancement scheme is not applicable in
	the flexi-cadre system. It was resolved in the 50 th BoG meeting that the
	Institute should study the models in some of the old IITs in this regard. Vide
	its letter dated 22.11.2022 (Annexure VI), the MoE has also reiterated that
	the scheme for faculty career advancement in the institute, as was earlier
	approved by BoG in March 2022, is contrary to the decision dated 14-3-
	2012 of the NIT Council and had accordingly not been approved by the
	Ministry; the MoE letter further states that it is requested to study the system

	These developments have understandably led to considerable disquiet and

	is necessary, and very much appreciated", and that formulation of a suitable
	scheme is imperative "to ensure that interest of the faculty members for
	career progression are not compromised".

	Based on the suggestions above from both BoG and the MoE that the
	Institute is requested to study the system in one of the well-established IITs,
	the Career Progression Schemes of the IITs at Bombay, Kanpur, and Madras
	have been examined (Annexures VI-A, VI-B & VI-C respectively). From
	amongst these, the scheme for faculty career growth which has previously
	been adopted at IIT Bombay through a resolution at its Board meeting held
	on 17.11.2021 (Annexure VI-A) was deemed as most suitable for adoption
	at IISER Mohali.
	Briefly, the IIT Bombay scheme emphasizes the importance of flexi-cadre
	for its faculty for rewarding excellence, so that any candidate who excels in
