	Following extensive discussions, the BoG has approved an extremely		
	rigorous Career Advancement scheme (CAS) for the Institute's faculty,		
	whose criteria include inter alia (i) academic excellence in research and		
	teaching, of a standard that is expected to be not inferior to that of a direct		
	recruit to the same position; (ii) residency period ordinarily of six years;		
	(iii) two successive levels of assessment, the first by an internal advisory		
	committee of Professors and the second by an external Assessment		
	Committee of experts chaired by the BoG Chairperson; (iv) requirement for		
	not less than five referees' reports, at least two of which are from		
	international experts; and, finally, (v) approval by the BoG of the		
	Assessment Committee's recommendations.		
	The Assessment Com	mittee under this scheme met on	a 29 th July 2022 with
	Prof. Ajay Sood, Chairperson BoG, in the Chair, and its recommendations		

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	were placed at the 49 th BoG meeting held on 30 July 2022. The BoG
	accorded approval in principle to the recommendations of the Assessment
	Committee, subject to concurrence of the Ministry of Education. The latter
	condition was included in the BoG resolution, since the Ministry had
	submitted comments that CAS is normally not followed / is not supported
	in institutions wherever flexi-cadre structure is there.
	The Institute had explained to the BoG, and has subsequently sent two
	letters to MoE (Annexure II, Page No.28-31 of the Agenda), that the
	institute has already converted its flexi-cadre structure to a fixed cadre for
	the different faculty levels, and that a reservation roster approved by BoG
	has also been prepared as mandated under the Central Educational
	Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act 2019. In this context, the
	Ministry is also at present addressing a complaint, which has been directed
	to it by the Hon'ble Standing Committee on SCs and STs and by the
	National Commission for Scheduled Castes, that IITs and CEIs are wilfully
	violating the provisions of the said Act in their procedure for faculty
	appointments in the name of flexi-cadre structure without preparing the
	cadre-wise faculty reservation rosters.
	Given that the placement of faculty at the higher designation under the CAS
	as adopted by the Institute is as rigorous as appointments made to the higher
	designation, the BoG is requested to approve that such placements under
	CAS are fully equivalent to fresh appointments. This same principle is
	followed for both faculty CAS in UGC, as well as for Scientists under S&T
	Ministry promoted through the Flexible Complementing Scheme. By
	analogy to these two schemes, the placement of faculty in the higher
	designation following this Institute's CAS is also personal to the individuals
	concerned.
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	The BoG is also requested to approve the proceedings of the CAS Assessment Committee meeting that was held on 30 July 2022.
	It is submitted for the consideration and approval of the Board.
	Comments of the Ministry of Education: Like IITs, IISERs follow flexi-
	cadre. There is no CAS in the flexi-cadre system. The examples of UGC/DST quoted in the agenda are not relevant here as they do not
	follow the system of flexi-cadre. The proposal is therefore not
	consistent with the policies and may not be approved. While career
	advancement of the faculty is necessary, and very much appreciated, it
	is suggested to study the system in some well-established IITs to ensure
	that interests of faculty members are not suffered.
	Initiating the discussion, the Director Prof. J.Gowrishankar pointed
	out the difficulties being faced by the institute in applying the roster
	(which is a requirement under the Act) on the flexi cadre of faculty
	positions. He mentioned about a complaint that has been forwarded to
	the MoE in which anomalies have been highlighted in implementation of faculty reservation as being followed in the IITs, and which has
	asked for the flexi cadre system therefore to be declared as invalid.
	The Director further pointed out that the practice being followed in
	some of the established IITs to which the MoE has referred apparently
	requires the availability of a large number of vacant sanctioned faculty
	posts. On the other hand, the Institute is having only 120 sanctioned
	positions of which nearly and 110 faculty are in place and a special recruitment drive cycle III is going on for the remaining posts.
	The Director also reiterated that the Faculty Career Advancement
	Scheme approved for the Institute by the BoG is extremely rigorous in

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	its standards and that the pending recommendations have been made by an Assessment Committee which was chaired by the BoG	
	Chairperson. Therefore, he strongly urged that these recommendations should be accepted and approved.	
	He further stressed that 51 additional faculty positions which have already been approved by BoG and are pending at the Ministry should	
	be immediately sanctioned to the institute. This sanction can be accorded by MoE itself, since the Finance Ministry has already	
	delegated this power to MoE. All the members present were unanimous in agreement that 51 faculty positions must be sanctioned at the	
	earliest. Dr. Alka Rao pointed out that the difficulties being faced in	
	implementing the suggested model of IITs may be communicated to the Ministry. Professor Sudeshna Sinha, Special Invitee emphasized that	
	the process for CAS which was undertaken at IISER Mohali was very rigorous and the process had taken a long time for completion.	
	therefore it must be honoured and accepted. She also added that the	
	present situation has created a very strong sense of despondency and disappointment amongst the faculty, since there was absolutely no	
	avenue for career progression being made available to them.	
Decision	The BoG resolved to recommend to the Ministry of Education to immediately sanction 51 faculty positions and also resolved that the	
	Institute should study the models in some of the old IITs as has been	
	suggested to ensure that interest of the faculty members for career progression are not compromised.

	Shri Shireesh Gupta, Advocate of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High	
	Court, has been serving as the legal adviser of IISER Mohali for the past	

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	four years on a current retainership of Rs 12000/- p.m. In the Institute's
	opinion, he has performed most competently during this period. Since 2020,
	he has represented the institute in more than 14 petitions in the Hon'ble
	High Court, one petition in the Hon'ble Supreme Court, and 06 cases in
	subordinate courts (Annexure III, Page No.32-33 of the Agenda). The
	Institute's position has been protected in all judgements delivered so far
	over the past three years, while the ongoing cases include three in the High
	Court, one in CAT, and two each in District Court and Labour court.
	Furthermore, Shri Gupta has provided valuable legal advice to the Institute
	on a variety of matters such as those relating to the Public Premises Act,
	student discipline, adherence to provisions of various Acts and DoPT orders
	etc.
	At its 49th meeting held on 30 July 2022, the BoG resolved that "Based on
	the comments of the IFD, the Board resolved that the Institute should start
	the process of empaneling legal advisor for IISER Mohali as per the rates
	approved by Law Ministry and that in the interim the present arrangement
	may continue for six more months". Since the Institute is of the opinion that
	continuity should be maintained, the Director and Registrar have discussed
	the matter of remuneration with Shri Gupta who has agreed to the rates as
	prescribed in the Ministry of Law and Justice OM No 26(1) 2014 Judl. dt
	01.10.2015 provided that it is suitably adjusted to cost of living increases
	(since the rates prescribed in the OM are seven years old). It is accordingly
	proposed that the Law Ministry rates with increase equivalent to the
	prevalent DA of 38% may be considered to compensate for inflation.
	The matter is for consideration of the BoG to decide upon continuing with
	Shri Shireesh Gupta as legal adviser at the prescribed rates as per Ministry
	of Law and Justice plus 38% thereon.
	It is submitted for the consideration and approval of the Board.
	Comemnts of the Ministry of Education: May be considered.

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Decision	The BoG approved the rates of the legal advisor and legal counsel as prescribed in the Ministry of Law and Justice OM No 26(1) 2014 Judl. dt 01.10.2015 plus increase equivalent to 38%. The Board further resolved that institute is to empanel more advocates in the list for representing the Institute in Court cases, but may retain present legal advisor as Legal Retainer, for advice to the Institute on any matter that may arise.

	another 51 faculty positions as per the approved Cabinet decision on IISERs	
	and the 10:1 student: faculty ratio. These positions have also already been	
	approved by BoG but their sanction has been referred to and is now pending	
	with Ministry of Finance despite the notification that powers for creation	
	of such posts in IISERs have been delegated to Ministry of Education. The	
	Institute is in urgent need of additional faculty in many Departments to	
	enable it to cope with the teaching requirements. The Institute has initiated	
	Minors programs in Data Science and Science Education which, in the	
	absence of suitable new regular faculty, are at present being taught by	
	retired faculty/industry experts. Likewise, HSS Department needs	
	additional faculty to teach courses in Philosophy of Science and in English;	
	Biology needs faculty in the areas of Ecology and Behavior and in	
	Computational Biosciences etc.	
	As per Clause 20(1) of the IISER Statutes, the Board may appoint any	
	person on contract for a period not exceeding five years, and the	
	Chairperson is to constitute the Selection Committees for making such	
	appointments. Accordingly, the BoG is requested to approve the	

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	appointments of up to ten faculty on contract for a period until the regular
	positions above have been sanctioned and filled.
	It is submitted for the consideration and approval of the Board.
	Comments of the Ministry of Education: May be considered.
	The Director explained that the emoluments and manner of filling up
	of the posts (which is only for teaching duties without research) shall
	be as per DoPT and UGC norms.
Decision	The Board approved the 10 contractual faculty positions subject to
	availability of funds.

B.O.G.22.50.08	Request for Sanction of Non-faculty Positions to the Institute
	The Institute has 1800 students in various programmes and the sanctioned
	strength of faculty positions are 120. As per the DPR, the ratio between
	students: faculty: non-faculty is 10:1:1.1. The Institute has been sanctioned
	96 positions of non-faculty, whereas with the numbers mentioned above,
	the number of non-faculty is to be 132. So, the institute is immediately short
	of 36 non-faculty positions.
	In addition to the above, 51 additional faculty positions have been approved
	by BoG and are pending for sanction by the Ministry of Education. With
	the sanction of these 51 positions, the total number of faculty positions will
	be 171and hence the total number of non-faculty positions would rise to
	188. The BoG in its 41 st Meeting had recommended creation of 85 positions
	of non-faculty to Ministry of Education but this matter is still pending.
	Since the Ministry of Finance has earlier already delegated to the Ministry
	of Education the powers to create positions as per the ratio of 10:1:1.1, the
	BoG is requested to recommend to the Ministry of Education to
	immediately sanction following 36 positions of non-faculty. As and when
	51 faculty positions will also be sanctioned by the Ministry of Education,

	and 30 July 2022, the BoG had decided that (i) there shall be mandatory
	gender segregation for 1st year BS-MS students and those below 18 years
	of age; (ii) for others, an opt-in choice shall be given to stay in non-
	segregated hostels, and the rules for such stay can be worked out in
	consultation with all stakeholders with the proviso that such rule are
	implementable; and (iii) these decisions are to be implemented on an
	amicable basis as far as possible, subject to strict adherence to fire safety
	norms and logistics.
	The new batch of around 250 1st year BS-MS students (MS22 batch) are
	expected to join the Institute around 30 October 2022. In an exercise
	undertaken by the Dean Students, around 1100 existing students have
	submitted their option to stay in non-segregated hostels; about 60 existing
	students have stated that they wish to stay in gender segregated hostels. The
	Dean Students has consulted the Director and then written to all students
	that one of the four Hostel buildings (Hostel 8) will be gender-segregated
	to accommodate both MS-22 students and the others who wish to stay there.

	OH-31 funds, and (ii) that the existing white list can continue to be used for
	supporting APC payment from CPDA or extramural project funds.
	Accordingly, several discussions have since been held amongst the faculty,
	and the Institute has also sought inputs from three external experts. It has
	been decided that the revised white list for which the institute will bear APC
	from OH-31 funds will be restricted to those from the previous white list
