Bose fellowship. He specially mentioned about the J. C. Bose fellowship to Professor Samrat Mukhopadhyay and award of the inaugural Tata Transformation Prize to Professor Purnananda Guptasarma. He congratulated all recipients and expressed satisfaction that the Institute is doing very well.

	The Institute has continued to perform exceedingly well during the year in both its teaching and research activities.  With regard to the teaching programs, the major changes implemented or envisaged for the coming academic year include (i) revision of curriculum and syllabus across all Departments; (ii) introduction of a Majors program in Earth Science and Environmental Science; (iii) implementation of pre-Majors in Year 2 of the BS-MS course; (iv) implementation of biometric attendance in the classes; (v) provision for students to secure credits for online courses; (vi) enrolment into the Academic Bank of Credits; (vii) uploading of all Ph.D. theses

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	<p>in the Shodhganga portal; and (viii) provision of additional entry/exit options to students in different courses. Many of these changes are aligned with the requirements of the National Education Policy (NEP) - 2020.</p> <p>With regard to research, some of the major achievements and publications during this period have been the following:</p> <p><b>A.</b> In a collaborative research endeavour between IISER Mohali, IIT Ropar, CSIR-IMTECH and IISc, and a new class of molecules (diphenylurea derivatives) have been identified that target the host cells and are able to robustly attenuate both SARS-CoV-2 and influenza virus infections (published in <i>PLOS Pathogens</i>: Indranil Banerjee).</p> <p><b>B.</b> With the use of single-molecule FRET, hidden structural subpopulations of the protein FUS have been discovered that drive dynamic network formation during liquid-liquid phase separation (published in <i>Nature Communications</i>: Samrat Mukhopadhyay).</p> <p><b>C.</b> A new class of water-soluble ionic photoswitches with excellent bistability have been prepared that show excellent bidirectional photoswitching, tunable half-lives of the photoswitched states from minute to year, and exceptional pH tolerance (published in the <i>Journal of the American Chemical Society</i>: Sugumar Venkataramani, Sanjay Singh).</p> <p><b>D.</b> From a simple organic molecule, a super-reductant has been developed which upon photoexcitation can cleave strong carbon-halogen bonds in a reductive fashion at a very demanding potential (published in the <i>Journal of the American Chemical Society</i>: Debashis Adhikari).</p> <p><b>E.</b> The economic burden of air pollution on India's wheat production has been assessed, along with quantifying the cost of ozone pollution for producers, consumers, and the government. The analysis indicates that farmer support policies need reexamination to maximize the social welfare of pollution mitigation for all stakeholders (published in <i>Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, USA</i>: Baerbel Sinha, Vinayak Sinha).</p>

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	<p><b>F.</b> A leucine-responsive axis in blood cell progenitors has been discovered that can mediate an autophagy-directed degradation of miRNA-bound mRNA in both fruit flies and humans. This work elucidates a novel mechanism through which autophagy can selectively initiate the clearance of target mRNA (published in <i>Nucleic Acids Research</i>: Lolitika Mandal, Sudip Mandal).</p> <p><b>G.</b> Thiol stress was shown to activate the hypoxia response pathway in the model organism <i>C. elegans</i>, challenging the current model that thiol stress affects only the endoplasmic reticulum milieu of the cell (published in <i>EMBO Journal</i>: Jogender Singh).</p> <p><b>H.</b> The patterning of plant shoots and stem cell differentiation were shown to be promoted by local biosynthesis of auxins (published in <i>Development</i>: Ram Yadav).</p> <p>The following awards and honours were received by the faculty during the year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prof. Samrat Mukhopdhyay and Dr. Lolitika Mandal, elected to Fellowship of the Indian National Science Academy</li> <li>• Profs. Arvind and Krishnendu Gongopadhyay, elected to Fellowship of the National Academy of Sciences (India)</li> <li>• Prof. Krishnendu Gongopadhyay, selected for SIRE Fellowship of DST-SERB</li> <li>• Prof. Purnananda Guptasarma, awarded the inaugural Tata Transformation Prize for Sustainability Research, with a value of Rs. 2 crore</li> <li>• Drs. Sugumar Venkatramani and Ujjal Gautam, awarded Bronze Medals of the Chemical Research Society of India</li> <li>• Dr. Mahak Sharma, selected for Associate Fellowship of the Indian National Science Academy</li> <li>• Dr. Jogender Singh, selected for H.G. Khorana Innovative Young Biotechnologist Fellowship of Deptt. of Biotechnology</li> </ul>

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	<p>Amongst the other notable activities and achievements, 17 faculty members have secured fresh extramural research grants in the first nine months of the financial year, aggregating to around Rs.7.2 crore in the first nine months of the financial year.. Five Ph.D. students of the Institute were selected for award of the Prime Minister's Research Fellowship (PMRF) in this year.</p> <p>Several other Ph.D. and BS-MS students were recipients of fellowships/travel awards for conferences/internships outside India</p>
<b>Decision</b>	<p><b>The Director pointed out that in addition to achievements of the Institute mentioned in the agenda, additional laurels have been bestowed i.e. Professor N. Sathyamurthy, Founder Director IISER Mohali being awarded INSA Distinguished Professorship which is to be hosted at IISER Mohali, and Professor Samrat Mukhopadhyay getting the J.C. Bose Fellowship. All the members congratulated the Institute for its achievements.</b></p>

	<p>Draft Minutes of the 53<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the BOG (<b>Annexure I, Page no. 1-41 of the agenda</b>) held on 06.10.2023 were circulated to the members and the following comments have been received from Technical Section, MoE, Government of India on agenda item no. 23.53.05 and 23.53.04.</p> <p><i>(i) Minutes against item 23.53.05 do not make a mention of observations made by Dr. Alka Rao. It was decided that the same would be reflected in the MoMs. The same may be indicated.</i></p> <p><i>(ii) Minutes against item 23.53.04: Details and modalities of any funding source, apart from HEFA or IRG, may be detailed before the Finance Committee before arriving at a decision (this is in reference to the FC item 23.43.10). This is particularly true in case if there is a financial implication on the Ministry. SFC/EFC are basically related to the delegation of powers, appraising, and approving authority depending on the funds required from Ministry. It does not appear SFC/EFC are separate funding sources.</i></p>

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	<p>In response to (i) above, it is submitted that during the discussion, Dr. Alka Rao pointed out that any employee aggrieved by the action or decision of the administration can file a grievance and the grievance may be allowed to go up to the ministry and may be up to the level of the Hon'ble Visitor if desired so. The ministry representative differed from this suggestion, mentioning that all institutions are autonomous institutions and that they should try to handle all the issues at their own level.</p> <p>The minutes as circulated state:</p> <p><b>“The members deliberated on the mechanism of grievance redressal and it was resolved that the grievances, if any, will be referred to grievance committee and the final decision will be taken by the Director, who will dispose of the grievance. In case of any appeal submitted against the Director’s decision, the appeal will be forwarded to the BoG Chairperson along with the Director’s observations thereon (with a copy sent to appellant). The Chairperson, BoG is at liberty to look at the appeal and the observations of the Director and take no further action, or to refer it back to the Director for further action as directed, or to discuss the issue in a subsequent BoG meeting.”</b></p> <p>In view of the comments of the technical section of the ministry, it is suggested that the draft resolution of the BoG above may be modified with the addition of the following as the last sentence: “Furthermore, any individual would be entitled to utilize additional grievance redressal mechanisms as provided by the Government.”</p> <p><b><u>For Confirmation with fresh resolution, please.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>The Registrar informed the BoG that he has also received inputs on additional matters pertaining to the Minutes from Professor N. G. Prasad, Member BoG on 27.12.2023, which are as follows:</u></b></p> <p>With respect to the draft minutes of the 53<sup>rd</sup> BOG meeting, the following may be corrected.</p> <p>1. Item BOG 23.53.04: The current minutes state “...The Registrar requested the ministry representative that the Institute will try to use corpus fund for HEFA loan and that ministry should support the shortfall if any. The BoG resolved to approve all the above recommendations.”</p>

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	<p>The last line gives the impression that the BOG has approved the use of corpus funds for construction of AB3. This is not correct. Following the input of the Ministry, there were general comments about various funding sources that can be explored and utilized. There is no concrete plan that has been submitted to the BOG for the utilization of Corpus funds. Therefore, there can be no blanket approval for use of corpus funds. The minutes should clearly reflect this stand.</p> <p>2. Item BOG 23.53.18: The minutes state “...His intentions are blatantly manoeuvring the system by taking the benefits.”</p> <p>These are aspersions being cast with no opportunity for the other party to defend their position. Moreover, these words are unnecessary to the issue at hand. Therefore, these words should be removed.</p>
<b>Decision</b>	<p><b>The BoG members discussed the comments of technical section and the points raised by Professor N. G. Prasad and resolved the modified decisions as under:</b></p> <p><b>“The members deliberated on the mechanism of grievance redressal and it was resolved that the grievances, if any, will be referred to grievance committee and the final decision will be taken by the Director, who will dispose of the grievance. In case of any appeal submitted against the Director’s decision, the appeal will be forwarded to the BoG Chairperson along with the Director’s observations thereon (with a copy sent to appellant). The Chairperson, BoG is at liberty to look at the appeal and the observations of the Director and take no further action, or to refer it back to the Director for further action as directed, or to discuss the issue in a subsequent BoG meeting. Furthermore, any individual would be entitled to utilize additional grievance redressal mechanisms as provided by the Government.”</b></p> <p><b>For Item no. BOG 23.53.04, it was resolved that the decision as indicated in the draft Minutes shall be modified to read as follows:</b></p> <p><b>“Noted except the item no. F.C.23.43.10, wherein the ministry representative, Sh. Priyank Chaturvedi pointed out that since the Institute has come out of the project mode, the building construction can taken up only through HEFA loan or through IRG. The Registrar pointed out that IISER Mohali is comparatively a new Institute and is in the field of basic sciences and is hence not in a position to generate much revenue from consultancy/patents. He also informed that the Institute does not have sufficient corpus money so as to take HEFA loan for the construction of</b></p>



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	<p><b>Academic Block-3. The Registrar requested the ministry representative that the Institute will try to use corpus fund for HEFA loan and that ministry should support the shortfall if any. The BoG took note of the observations above.”</b></p> <p><b>Inputs on Item no. BOG 23.53.18 were not taken into consideration as Professor N. G. Prasad himself agreed that the item was not discussed in the BoG meeting.</b></p> <p><b>The BOG noted the above-mentioned observations and the Minutes of the 53<sup>rd</sup> meeting were confirmed with the changes indicated above..</b></p>

	The URR of the non-faculty of IISERs was approved by the ministry on 07.09.2022, which were subsequently adopted by the BoG IISER Mohali in its 50 <sup>th</sup> meeting held on 10.11.2022. Subsequently, based on the representations received, the ministry constituted a committee comprised of Prof. A. Natu as Chairperson and all the Directors to give their suitable recommendations regarding para 'B' of the URR. All the Registrars of IISERs also met in IISER Thiruvananthapuram on 02-03 April 2023 to discuss this matter and subsequently the committee headed by Professor Arvind Natu submitted its report to the MoE ( <b>Annexure-II of the Agenda</b> ). The MoE has accepted the report with the following observations ( <b>Annexure- III of the Agenda</b> ):

	<p>1. (i) The criteria of minimum service of 2 year for promotion from L8 to L9 and L9 to L10 not to be restricted to the post of Private Secretary only as recommended by the Committee but will be applicable to all cadres within same levels.</p> <p>(ii) The criteria of minimum service of 5 year for promotion from L11 to L12 not to be restricted to the post of Executive Engineer only, but extended to other cadres within the level as well.</p> <p>2. The said Uniform Recruitment Rules including Part A and Part B and general instructions for consideration, approval, and adoption by IISER Mohali are annexed <b>(Annexure-IV of the Agenda)</b>.</p> <p>In addition to the approvals accorded by Ministry of Education, the Institute is proposing the following changes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The employees working on contract with IISER Mohali will be given age relaxation (in addition to admissible age relaxation as per the Government of India rules) limited to the period they had worked in IISER Mohali.</li> <li>2. An employee in the post of Executive Engineer will be designated as Superintending Engineer (personal to the incumbent) when he moves from pay level 12 to pay level 13. Decision	<p>The Registrar read the Addendum of Agenda item no. B.O.G.23.54.06 as circulated on 28.12.2023.</p> <p>He pointed out that the Institute is following the policy, as desired by MoE, that the recruitment rules should be uniform across all IISERs and that if this addendum is approved it will clarify the ambiguity for the prospective application of the policy.</p> <p>Regarding the proposal for age relaxation for employees working on contract at IISER Mohali, Professor N. G. Prasad requested that the same may also be extended to employees provided by the outsourced agency since some of them have been working since last 10 years or more and are providing exemplary services to the Institute. The Registrar explained that many of these employees could not apply earlier for regular employment as the Institute initially had very few sanctioned positions and furthermore many positions could not filled due to the absence of recruitment rules.</p> <p>During the discussion and in response to clarifications sought by the BoG members, Registrar pointed out that this proposed relaxation will be given as a one-time provision and will be restricted to age ceiling only, and that no relaxation in qualification and other criteria will be given; moreover, the concerned individuals will have to compete for the open selection. The Registrar also explained that all recruitments to group B and group C are done solely through written examination, where the papers are set by multiple external examiners and the whole process is transparent and fair.</p>

	<p>With regard to the proposal of giving designation of Superintendent Engineer to an Executive Engineer upon being upgraded, the Registrar explained that this will be personal to the incumbent and that when he/she retires, it is the post of Executive Engineer which will be rendered vacant. The Director explained that it is similar to Career Advancement scheme for faculty and librarians in the University system, and to DACP of medical officers, all of which are professional cadre posts. One member opined that this provision may be extended to all the cadres of Engineering wing to which the Registrar reiterated that since we are looking for Uniform Recruitment Rules across all IISERs and most of the meetings of the BoGs of different IISERs are happening this week, Registrars of all 7 IISERs may need to sit together to have a look at the documents of respective IISERs and try to make them uniform in line with Uniform Recruitment Rules across all IISERs. Some other members also opined that similar requests may come from employees in other cadres, to which Registrar replied that the other cadres are administrative or technical and as and when we receive such requests, they will be brought to the BoG for consideration.
