Symposium on The Works of Fields Medalists 2022

The Fields Medal is a prize awarded to (up to four) mathematicians under forty years of age at the International Congress of Mathematicians (ICM), a meeting that takes place every four years. The award is for recognizing outstanding mathematical achievement for existing work and for the promise of future achievement. The Fields Medal is regarded as one of the highest honors a mathematician can receive, and has been described as the Nobel Prize of Mathematics.



The last ICM was held in July this year where four mathematicians have been awarded the Fields Medal. In this symposium exposures of the recent work of the Fields medalists will be given to a less specialized audience. All the talks will be delivered by mathematicians working at IISER Mohali and each talk will be of 50 minutes.
