

Prof. Dr. Holger F. Bettinger, University of Tübingen

Holger Bettinger studied chemistry at the Friedrich-Alexander University Erlangen-Nuremberg, Germany, and received his doctoral degree under the guidance of Prof. Dr. P. v. R. Schleyer in 1998. He conducted postdoctoral research at the University of Georgia (Athens, GA, USA) and Rice University (Houston, TX, USA). Habilitation at the Ruhr-University Bochum, Germany, (2005, mentor Prof. Dr. W. Sander) was supported by a Liebig Fellowship. He became Heisenberg Fellow in 2006, and accepted his current position at the University of Tübingen in 2008. Since 2021, he is Director of the Institute of Organic Chemistry at the University of Tübingen. He is author of more than 210 papers in the areas of reactive polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, boron-nitrogen substituted aromatic compounds, carbonaceous materials, and boron and boron-nitrogen analogues of organic reactive intermediates. His research was awarded with the K.-H.-Eberle Foundation Price and more recently with an ERC Synergy Grant.
